1/4 Local Officer Elections Begin

FEBRUARY 2010

2/1 Local Officer Nominations Open

Elections will include General Council Delegates and Alternates; and may include bargaining delegates where applicable.

MARCH 2010

3/1 Local Officer Ballots prepared and mailed to local members

Local Officer Election balloting, voting, deadlines, and ballot counting throughout March

APRIL 2010

4/1 Local Officer Election balloting, voting, deadlines, and ballot counting throughout April

4/30 Deadline: Local Officer and General Council Elections complete.

Election Results and GC Credential Reports due to Salem HQ by 5 PM

MAY 2010

5/1 Newly elected Local Officers take office

AUGUST 2010

8/4 Pre- General Council meetings, GC Committee training, and Delegate Orientation

8/5-7 GENERAL COUNCIL CONVENTION
